AAE Annual Session 2015

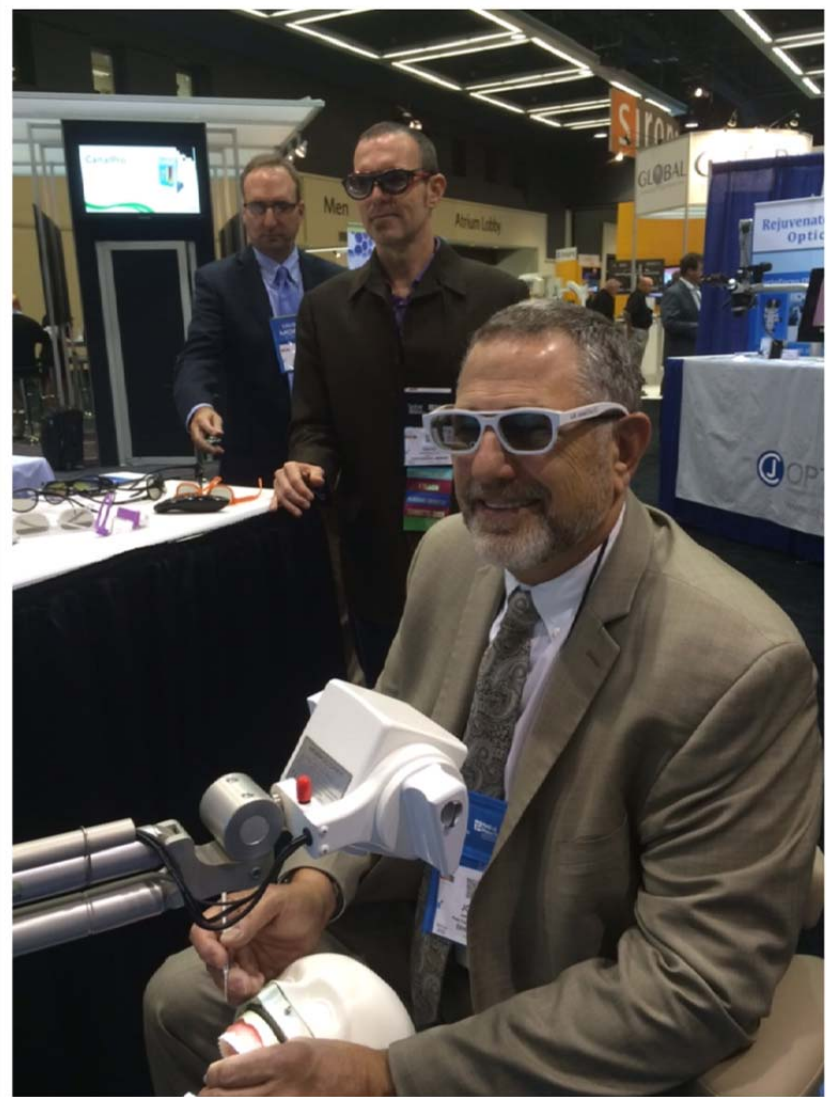
